# Our Signature Programs

## ESTA

Eliada Students Training for Advancement

ESTA serves transitioning youth, 18-25 years old who are homeless or at risk of homelessness.



## Foster Care

Our foster care programs promote permanent family living arrangements for children ages 0-21 years old through reunification, guardianship, and adoption. These programs include Family Foster Care, Therapeutic Foster Care, and Respite Care.

Our families have assigned consultants who ensure that the families and youth have what's needed to succeed.

## HOP

Under the ESTA umbrella is DHHS's Healthy Opportunities Pilot Program to provide food security and housing assistance for those in need.



# Residential Treatment

---

Eliada's level-3 residential cottage is designed to house students who require higher levels of care for extended periods. Our goal is to return students to their family homes with varying levels of support at home and school or to step them down to a therapeutic foster care level with additional support.



## Intensive In-Home

---

This program is a home-based mental health service. It focuses on providing children the tools they need to manage their behavior while maintaining healthy dynamics in their home and community. It is designed to meet the child's and family's needs through crisis management, counseling, case management, family therapy, and skill building.

# Child Development

---

Eliada is proud to offer our NC 5-star accredited childcare facility as an affordable daycare for working families. First priority is given to unserved children, followed by underserved children. We emphasize positive growth for the cognitive, physical, social, and emotional aspects of development. We focus on a child's strengths; and family diversity, culture, and language are respected in the classroom.

## After School & Summer Camp

---

Eliada's On-Campus After School Program helps our K-12 year old children spend their afternoons developing their literacy and STEM skills while also providing a safe space to explore and have fun! Our classrooms, heated pool, hiking trails, and farm full of animal friends provide great spaces for our Summer Camp students to focus on peer relations, conflict resolution, character building, and building self-esteem.



# Equine Therapy

---

Equine Outpatient serves both residential and community-referred clients in a trauma-informed, experiential therapy setting. We utilize the Eagala and ARCH models of equine-assisted psychotherapy. We believe that clients, when given a safe space and empowered by their treatment team, can find and implement their own solutions.

## Day Treatment

---

Day treatment occurs at our on-campus school, Eliada Academy. The Eliada Academy's mission is to provide a supportive and transformative environment for students who require specialized behavioral healthcare.



## Campus Farming

---

The farm integrates with Eliada's program curriculums, offering accredited agriscience classes that cover topics like gardening, conservation, farm ecology, irrigation, and pest control. The produce from the farm directly contributes to creating nutritional meals for the students served on campus.
